# 議案 CC (Measure CC)

在7月份,董事會批准在11月份的投票 中投放一項價值 2.75 億美元的學校債券 Measure CC(議案CC)。議案CC 將允許 FUHSD (菲利蒙聯合高中學區) 在議案 B 和 K 下,在所有五間至少有50年歷史的 高中校園內,延續已開始建設的教室和現 代化設施。在議案B和K之下,我們能夠 在整個學區建立 127 個新教室。在議案 CC下,延續這現代化的程序,將包括必 要的基礎設施升級,並將在 Cupertino (庫比蒂諾),Fremont(菲利蒙), Homestead (霍姆斯特德), Lynbrook (林布魯克)和 Monta Vista (蒙塔維斯 塔)高中,其餘400間尚未更新的教室進 行升級,以便所有學生和教師都有先進和 現代化的教室和設施。在菲利蒙聯合高中 學區的所有選民,將會被要求在2018年 11 月 6 日的投票中,對議案 CC 進行投票。

現代化每個教室,將包括新的暖氣,通風和空調(HVAC)系統,更換 LED 燈光和天花板,火警警報和灑水器,技術更新,新家俱,油漆和修補,屋頂和地板。

議案 CC 將提供嚴格的問責制,所有基金都會由獨立公民監督委員會作年度審查。該區內的產業擁有者,年度平均最高為每100,000 美元評估價值付 16 美元(非市場價值)。FUHSD 很自豪能夠在標準普爾(Aaa)和穆迪(AAA)的信用評級中,學區獲得最高的信用評級。這允許學區能夠以優惠的利率為債券再融資,並節省納稅人的金錢。

除了學區內產業擁有者的支持外,FUHSD 還利用其他近期債券,共獲得1160萬美 元(來自提案 39 的 220 萬美元,大大提高了我們的節省能源,來自州債券發行的 OPSC 資金為 910 萬美元,以及州輪胎補助金 300,000 美元)。我們已經在州職業和技術教育基金,申請額外的金額,來支持目前在 Homestead 高中興建的創新中心。

# Measure CC Fact Sheet

Thank you to the voters of the Fremont Union High School District (FUHSD), who generously approved two school bond measures in recent years. In 2008, the District passed Measure B, with the intent of modernizing and building some classrooms, building new cafeterias and making necessary upgrades to infrastructure. However, a few years into Measure B, it became apparent that a significant increase in enrollment was headed our way and that we needed to focus our priorities on building more new classrooms and other buildings that would accommodate our enrollment growth. Using the Measure B dollars and the subsequent Measure K bond, we've been able to build 127 new classrooms district-wide and much more.

The following projects were completed or are under construction with funds from Measures B and K:

Given that our schools are all fifty years old or older, we are returning to the essential priorities of infrastructure upgrades and modernization of the remaining 400 classrooms that have not been touched. Measure CC is a \$275 million school bond that would be used to continue the renovation and modernization of Cupertino, Fremont, Homestead, Lynbrook and Monta Vista high schools so that **all** students and teachers have updated and modern classrooms and facilities. All voters in the Fremont Union High School District will be asked to vote on Measure CC on the November 6, 2018 ballot.

#### Measure CC will:

- Modernize our older high school classrooms and science labs to meet today's educational standards for science, technology, engineering, arts and math;
- Repair and replace leaky windows and roofs, old plumbing and HVAC systems;
- Provide seismic upgrades;
- Upgrade school safety and security systems;
  and
- Improve facility access for disabled students and staff.

Future needs at each site which could be funded by Measure CC include the following:

- Classroom Modernization (100, 300, 400, 500 Wings)
- Music Room Expansion
- Visual and Performing Arts Courtyard
- Field Upgrades
- Replacement of Canopy System connecting classroom wings

- Field House
- Wrestling Room
- Field Upgrades

#### **Homestead**

- Renovation on Buildings A, B, C and L
- Seismic safety work
- Modernization of Building S, Library, Library Quad and Gym Lobby

#### Lynbrook

- Classroom Modernization (70, 100, 200, 300, 400, 500 & 600 Wings)
- STEM/Maker Space and Robotics Center
- Science Classroom Modernization
- Additional Aditorium renovation and upgrades
- Field Upgrades

Measure CC provides strict accountability, with all funds audited annually and reviewed by an independent citizens' oversight committee, and funds cannot be used for school administrator or teacher salaries. However, energy and maintenance savings costs from the modernized buildings would save money that could help financially support our teachers and staff.

The average yearly cost to property owners in the District would be \$16 per \$100,000 of assessed value (not market value).

FUHSD is proud to have the highest possible credit rating for a school district from both Standard and Poor's (Aaa) and Moody's (AAA). This has allowed the District to refinance bonds at favorable rates and save taxpayer money.

In addition to the local support from property owners, FUHSD has leveraged other recent bonds to receive a total of 11.6 million additional dollars (\$2.2 million from Prop 39, which greatly improves our energy savings, \$9.1 in OPSC funding from the state bond issue, and \$300,000 from a state tire grant). We have applied for additional dollars from a state Career and Technical Education grant to support the Homestead High School Innovation Hub, which is currently under construction and will continue to seek any opportunity to leverage our bond funds.
